An Olpe type soil from the Kenoma-Olpe complex. Soil has a mollic epipedon in the top 40 cm and rounded chert gravel is found in the 40 to 80 cm range. Chert gravel sits on top of sandstone, shale, and limestone bedrock below 130 cm.
